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Intratympanic Steroid Injections

Complications; could occur weeks, months, or even years later:

1. Failure to achieve objective of treatment, i.e. failure to achieve hearing improvement and/or failure to eradicate completely the disease process.
2. Post-treatment perforation of the eardrum.
3. Development of hearing loss, including total deafness in the treated ear.
4. Creation of disequilibrium (vertigo); immediate or delayed.
5. Tinnitus (or noises in the head).
6. Interference with sensation of taste.
7. Development of post treatment bleeding or ear infections.
